MINUTES of the SPECIAL MEETING

of the BOARD of COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

for SAN MIGUEL COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

HELD FEBRUARY 19, 2024 AT 1:00 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER

The San Miguel County Board of Commissioners held a special meeting on Monday, February 19, 2024. Commission Chairman Harold Garcia called the meeting to order at 1:00 PM at the San Miguel County Administration Complex, 500 W. National Avenue in the Commission Chambers Suite 201, Las Vegas, New Mexico 87701.

2. ROLL CALL

Chief Deputy Clerk Jacob Gonzales administered roll-call: Chairman Harold Garcia - present, Vice-Chairman Martin Sena - present, Commissioner Janice Varela - present, Commissioner Max Trujillo – present and Commissioner Kenneth Medina - present.

A quorum is present.

NEW BUSINESS

6. AWARD CONTRACT FOR WELL DRILLING AT SHERIDAN FIRE DEPARTMENT

Fire Chief Andrew Duran asked for approval to award contract to Rocky Road Gravel and Drilling for the construct of the well at the Sheridan Fire Department. Two other companies (Hydro and KP Venture Drilling) queried the RFP; however, Rocky Road was the only entity that submitted a bid. The cost for the construction components of the well drilled to 100 feet is bid at \$19,000 with an \$80 per foot charge in excess of 100 feet.

Motion to award bid for well drilling at the Sheridan Fire Station to Rocky Road Gravel and Drilling made by Commissioner Max Trujillo. Second by Vice Chairman Martin Sena. Motion carried.

7. RECOMMENDATION FOR APPROVAL OF COMPREHENSIVE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PLAN TO BRING COUNTY ASSESSOR FUNCTION INTO STATUTORY, REGULATORY AND COUNTY COMPLIANCE

County Manager Joy Ansley read a Letter into the Record regarding the operational standards and violations (concerns) cited by NM Taxation and Revenue's Property Tax Division; as well as

various employee grievances and supervisory tactics that have been noted in Human Resources in relation to the office of the Assessor of San Miguel County. This Letter is available unedited in hard-copy form, PDF form and/or audio recording in the County Clerk's office.

Manager Ansley asked for approval from the Commission to officially assist in personnel matters and develop a cohesive plan to address the concerns cited by the NM Taxation and Revenue Property Tax Division, and to develop policies that will properly cite parcels with the correct acreage and tax due to the correct property owner. Manager Ansley noted that as an elected official the Assessor's office does not report to the Manager's office: and the Commission, statutorily, has control of the budget. However, Manager Ansley feels that the discrepancies in operations may leave the County vulnerable to personnel legal issues and continued discontent by property owners, and continued citations from NM Taxation & Revenue Property Tax Division. County Attorney H. Chico Gallegos stressed that this proposal by the Manager's office is to offer technical expertise in developing procedures and to assist in managing daily operations in the Assessor's office. Attorney Gallegos is comfortable that legal sufficiency is met with this Letter.

Motion to approve the Manager's Office to provide technical expertise and to develop a comprehensive plan to bring the San Miguel County's Assessor's office to address concerns from the NM Taxation & Revenue's Property Tax Division and personnel issues made by Commissioner Max Trujillo. Second by Commissioner Harold Garcia. Motion carried.
